QUARTERLY The following matters were discussed or adopted: Christian Kazemba was welcomed as a voting member. A new A/C unit was installed at the teacherage at a lower-than-expected cost. The boiler in the church was replaced at a price of \$8,200. The plan is to redo the sidewalks in front of the church. Bids for installing new siding on the church came in at anywhere from \$110-\$130k. The cost for foam board insulation for the church was \$5,200. The cost for filling the walls with foam was \$9,300. Contractors recommended that the windows be done first. The Treasurer's report showed that offerings for the CLC are approximately \$5,400 ahead of budget. Some of the fencing at the cemetery was affected by the amount of snow this past winter. VBS will be held the week of July 17. The summer schedule will begin on Memorial Day weekend, vs. the Sunday following. Larry Boernsen and Craig Ahrens will represent the congregation at the MN Delegate Conference at Inver Grove Heights on June 10. Next Quarterly Meeting: July 16.
