

#### + The Sermon +



For I consider that the sufferings of this present time are not worth comparing with the

glory that is to be revealed to us. <sup>19</sup> For the creation waits with eager longing for the revealing of the sons of God. <sup>20</sup> For the creation was subjected to futility, not willingly, but because of him who subjected it, in hope <sup>21</sup> that the creation itself will be set free from its bondage to corruption and obtain the freedom of the glory of the children of God. <sup>22</sup> For we know that the whole creation has been groaning together in the pains of childbirth until now. <sup>23</sup> And not only the creation, but we ourselves, who have the firstfruits of the Spirit, groan inwardly as we wait eagerly for adoption as sons, the redemption of our bodies. <sup>24</sup> For in this hope we were saved. Now hope that is seen is not hope. For who hopes for what he sees? <sup>25</sup> But if we hope for what we do not see, we wait for it with patience. <sup>26</sup> Likewise the Spirit helps us in our weakness. For we do not know what to pray for as we ought, but the Spirit himself intercedes for us with groanings too deep for words. <sup>27</sup> And he who searches hearts knows what is the mind of the Spirit, because the Spirit intercedes for the saints according to the will of God.

**Mon John 4:4-24** Jesus asks a drink from a Samaritan woman, but would rather give her much more (v14). He shows her the need for spiritual wisdom to worship God in spirit and in truth (v24).

**Tues 1 Corinthians 2:1-5** The apostle uses his own example to show that faith does not come through human wisdom, but by the persuading power of the Holy Spirit.

**Wed 1 Corinthians 2:6-10** There is indeed a wisdom at work among God's people, but it is not the world's wisdom. It is the wisdom that God reveals to us through His Spirit (v10).

**Thurs Genesis 22:1-19** Abraham's faith is tested when He is told to offer Isaac up to God. Abraham's faith in God's promises survive the test and the Lord provides a ram to be offered up instead of his son.

Fri Micah 6:1-8 The Lord accuses His people of rebelling against Him (v1-5), and Israel's response is to remember His word which requires doing justice, loving mercy, and walking humbly with their God (v6-8).

**Sat 1 Thessalonians 4:9-12** The apostle Paul commends the Thessalonians' brotherly love, and encourages them to do so even more, conducting themselves decently toward outsiders as well.
